


SHAWNIGAN IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT

BY-LAW NO. 106

A bylaw providing authority to respond to incidents beyond the boundary of the improvement district under certain circumstances.

The Trustees of the Shawnigan Improvement District ENACT AS FOLLOWS:


1. In addition to any agreement to provide services beyond the boundary of the improvement district, at the direction of the Fire Chief or his designate, the fire department may respond to requests for assistance beyond the boundary of the improvement district.
2. The authority in Section 1 may only be exercised in relation to the following services:
 - (a) fire suppression;
 - (b) search and rescue;
 - (c) assistance where there is a risk of immediate harm to persons or property including:
 - (i) medical emergencies;
 - (ii) hazardous material incidents;
 - (iii) traffic accidents.
3. The authority in Section 1 may only be exercised if a local government does not provide the same service in that area.
4. This by-law may be cited as the "Shawnigan Improvement District Fire Department Boundary  Operations Bylaw".

INTRODUCED and given first reading by the Trustees on the 13th day of June, 2005.


